


2023 Highlights

1) We Deserve Better: In collaboration with our comrades at Survivors Know, we conducted an assessment that yielded responses from 265 advocates. To share the findings, we hosted a 3-part virtual summit.

2) Podcasts & Presentations: In addition to the We Deserve Better summit, we facilitated 5 workshops for over 100 anti-violence professionals, and were featured on 2 podcasts.

3) Growing Our Community: We more than doubled the membership of our Discord community and Instagram followers. Our online community allows us to connect with advocates around the world.



We Deserve Better

At the end of 2022, Survivors Know & The SOAR Collective administered a survey to learn about the experiences of anti-violence advocates. We were thrilled to receive 265 responses from 33 U.S. states and territories.


We then hosted a three-part virtual summit in April, June & July. Our goal was to unite advocates, explore the findings, and collectively develop recommendations and solutions.

We are so grateful to everyone who shared their stories with us, participated in the summit, and helped spread the word.


Growing Our Community:

Instagram allows us to connect with advocates all over the world. In just two years, we've gone from less than 100 followers to nearly 1000.

We host Advocate Chat, a free connection space on Discord. Advocates can create an anonymous account to vent, ask questions, and share resources. We doubled our membership from last year and the chat was active 60 days this year.

This spring, we plan to launch the We Deserve Better website and report, which includes resources and actionable recommendations for advocates, organizational leaders, funders, and TA providers.
